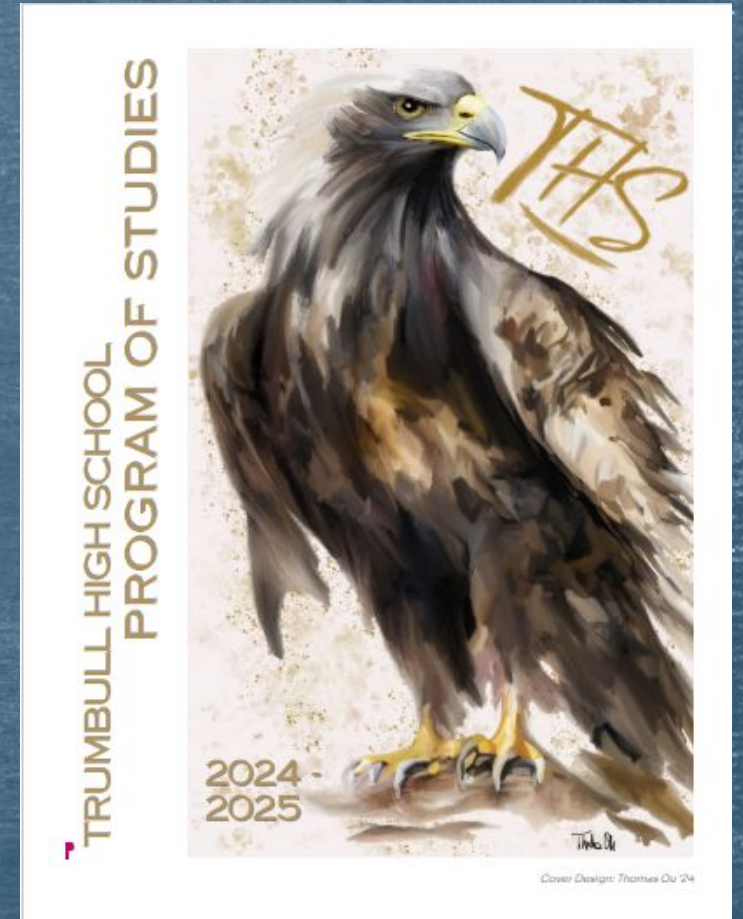

Course Selection

What is the PSAT?



- ▶ Product of the College Board
- ▶ Preliminary/practice test, meant as practice for the actual SAT

When do students take the PSAT?

- ▶ Sophomores and Juniors at Trumbull High take the PSAT in the fall of each year

Why Do Students Take the PSAT?

- ▶ To practice for the actual SAT
- ▶ Score reports can highlight what areas students need to focus on to prepare for the SAT

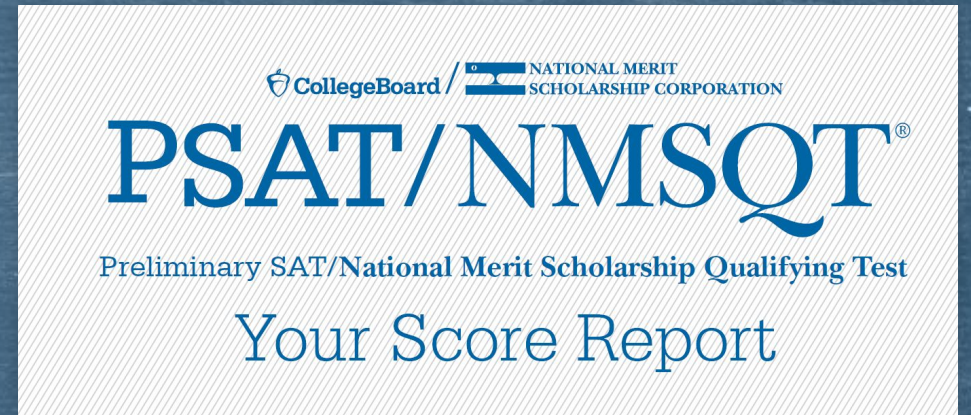
What are the SAT & ACT?

- ▶ National standardized tests that aid colleges in evaluating college applicants
- ▶ **One** component of the college admissions process (most schools are now test optional)
- ▶ The SAT will be taken as a CT state testing requirement at THS in your junior year
- ▶ You can register for other SAT/ACT testing dates during your Junior/Senior years

Naviance Steps:

1. Go to the Trumbull High School website
2. Hover over the school counseling tab on the top
 - ▶ click Naviance
3. Put in zip code, click Trumbull High
 - ▶ select "Student"
 - ▶ click blue CONTINUE WITH SINGLE SIGN ON button - need to be logged into trumbullps.net account on Chrome browser
4. Click 'planner' tab (top, middle of screen)
 - ▶ goals
 - ▶ click on goal(s) to review details **if you don't have a goal listed you can add one now**
5. Complete goals survey
 - click on your initials at the top right hand corner of your screen
 - surveys from your school
 - **Freshmen Check-in** **if you just created a goal, you can fill out the survey based on the goal you just created**
