

WHY DO STUDENTS TAKE THE PSAT?

- To practice for the actual SAT
- Score reports can highlight what areas students need to focus on to prepare for the SAT

WILL I TAKE THE PSAT AGAIN?

WHAT ARE THE SAT & ACT?

- National standardized tests that aid colleges in evaluating college applicants
- One component of the college admissions process (many schools are now test optional)
- The SAT will be taken as a CT state testing requirement in your junior year, other SAT/ACT testing dates you can register for in your junior/senior year





WHAT IS THE MASTERY BASED LEARNING ASSESSMENT (MBLA)?

Mastery Based Learning is not a specific course or experience, however every high school student across the state of Connecticut will be asked to engage in activities that support their obtaining a 1.0 credit in MBLA. This credit is required in order to graduate from THS. The credit will be awarded through each student's work and participation in (a) advisory sessions, (b) across academic classes and (c) work/civic related experiences outside of school.

Today, each sophomore at Trumbull High School will work toward a portion of obtaining this MBLA credit (1.0). We are asking that each student please take the time to thoroughly complete the activity.




- Tool that is loosely based on Myers Briggs Personality Type Indicator, to help you learn about your personality type
